### Clark County, Washington

**Tuesday, April 28, 2015**

On Tuesday, April 28, 2015, in Clark County, State of Washington, a special election will be held for the purpose of submitting to the voters for their approval and adoption or rejection, a joint resolution for City of Woodland, Clark County Fire Protection District No. 2, and Clark County Fire Protection District No. 11 – DBA Clark County Fire & Rescue, as listed below.

#### **Voter registration deadlines**

The deadline for initial mail-in or online registrations and transfers or updates to an existing registration is 5 p.m., Monday, March 30, 2015.

If you are **not** registered in Washington State by March 30, you may still register, but you must do so **in person** at the Elections Department by 5 p.m., April 20.
