

**NOTICE OF
DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE
(DNS)**

The Clark County Department of Environmental Services has issued a determination of non-significance (DNS) under the State Environmental Policy Act Rules (Chapter 192-11 WAC) to adopt and update changes in the Clark County Stormwater Manual and code (13.26A Water Quality and 40.385 Stormwater and Erosion Control), as a non-project SEPA review required by law (RCW 36.81.121 and WAC 136.16.010).

After review of a completed environmental checklist and other supporting information on file with the agency, Clark County Department of Environmental Services has determined that this proposal will not have a probable significant impact on the environment. Project specific environmental impacts shall be evaluated during individual project design processes.
