

Charter Element Priorities

CLARK COUNTY BOARD OF FREEHOLDERS (BOF)

During its regular meeting on December 10, 2013 the BOF approved the following priorities as it deliberates on elements to be considered for inclusion in the Clark County Charter. The first priority on the list shall initiate deliberation during the meeting on December 16, 2013. It is anticipated that additional deliberation priorities will be established by the BOF as it progresses in its development of the Charter.

Priority Number One

Separation of executive and legislative branches of county government.

- ↳ Related Discussions: - Transfer of executive powers from the Board of Commissioners to an elected County Executive.
- Transfer of executive powers from the Board of Commissioners to an appointed County Manager.

Priority Number Two

Increase the number of commissioners or county councilmembers from three to five.

- ↳ Related Discussion: - Increase the number of commissioners or county councilmembers to a number greater than five.

Priority Number Three

Elect commissioners or county councilmembers by district instead of at-large.

Priority Number Four

Establish for the people the powers of initiative and referendum.
