SUBJECT: Additional Information/Clarifications to Specifications

Question 1) Vendor is licensed in both Oregon & Washington. If staff are placed immediately (January 1, 2016), do they need to be WA certified immediately?

Answer 1) We will work with the vendor on a timeline. However, they must meet the background requirements at the time of placement.

Question 2) What is the minimum age requirement?

Answer 2) 21 years of age

Question 3) Is there a minimum wage requirement by the County/Sheriff's Office?

Answer 3) Minimum wage is only as required by State/Federal law; nothing different is required by Clark County.

Question 4) Is there any vehicle provided by the County?

Answer 4) No. Vendor may provide their own vehicle (see RFP for insurance requirements, etc.). The campus is so small a vehicle really isn't necessary.

Question 5) What about parking for staff (personal vehicles)?

Answer 5) It is the same as for any other County employee. They can pay to park in garage; or pay for permit from City. (Or park in unmetered spaces, on the street, as available.)

Question 6) How many hours of on-the-job training are required?

Answer 6) There are no requirements set by the County/Sheriff's Office. Staff should meet whatever vendor's training standards are.

Question 7) Regarding attachment A, "Total Funds Requested Under this Proposal", please clarify the period requested E.G. Annual.

Answer 7) The period requested is Annual.

Question 8) In section 2C. #5 Project Approach and Understanding- Please give clarification and direction for the last sentence in the paragraph. "The provider should prove an adequate Budget Summary and that summary identifies sufficient man-hours for the project and that summary is complete and reasonable."

Answer 8) The sentence should read, "The provider should provide an adequate budget summary and that summary identifies sufficient man-years for the project and that summary is complete and reasonable." We want to make sure you've identified how many man-hours it will take to provide the required services and that your estimates are complete and reasonable.

Question 9) Will the county release the current pricing information for the current vendor contract.

Answer 9) **That information is available to vendors through a public disclosure request.**
