UPDATE ON HIGHWAY 99 SIDEWALKS AND IMPROVEMENTS the interim sidewalk project is completed on the west side of Highway 99 between NE 102nd St and NE 117th St. We appreciate that Clark County has taken some action on this. While it is an improvement, it seems that more work is needed to upgrade safety. We will continue to lobby Clark County Commissioners to focus on Highway 99 improvements that were announced in May 2006.

NEW TRAFFIC SIGNAL ON NE 119TH ST. the new traffic light at the intersection of Salmon Creek Avenue and NE 119th Street is completed and now up and functioning. Pedestrian crossings were included for safety on this busy arterial road.

SPIRIT OF CLARK COUNTY AWARD GIVEN FOR 78TH STREET EXIT LANDSCAPE PLANTING PROJECT - the planting project at the 78th Street exit of Interstate 5 was honored with the award earlier this year. Thank you to the many volunteers from Sherwood Neighborhood who helped including; June Yamrick, Linda Gilmore, Bill and Bridget McLeman, Cliff Richard and Roben White. The award was presented during the Annual State Of Clark County Address for best group project. The 3000 daffodil bulbs should bloom year after year and the 135 trees will become more established over time.
