


What is Universal Green Design?

- It is one solution that works for everyone
- An idea of making things comfortable and convenient for people who:
 - Have families with young children
 - Want to stay in their home as they grow older
 - Want to simplify their housekeeping
 - Are taller or shorter than average
 - Need extra help getting around
 - Want to lower their energy bills



ENTRANCE, EXTERIOR AND MAIN AREAS

- Open space inside front door
- Peepholes at different heights for children and adults, or long glass panel by door
- Lighted doorbell
- Covered entryway with bench or shelf
- Large, simple house numbers
- Level walkways flanked by solar lights
- Easy access to electrical panel, water shut-off, energy-efficient water heater and thermostat
- Audio and visual smoke and carbon monoxide detectors
- Native plants for easy care





36-Inch Wide Minimum Accessible Route Through Dwelling Unit

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Usable Folding Door

KITCHEN

- Counters/workspaces at different heights
- Pull-out, adjustable shelves and drawers
- Drop-down shelves in upper cabinets
- Removable cabinet doors under sink
- Rounded cabinet and counter edges
- Color-contrast counter edging
- Folding lower cabinet doors
- Dishwasher on platform or over storage



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BATHROOM


- Lower, water-saving toilet for children; higher one for older adults
- Easy-to-reach or wall-mounted toilet flush
- Adjustable-height, hand-held shower head
- Curbless shower with built-in or folding seat
- Reinforced walls for shower- and toilet-area grab bars
- Plumbing at wall for clear access under sink, or wall-mounted sink
- Full-length, wall-mounted mirror



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





BEDROOM

- Clear access to bed, closet and window
- Extra outlets and switches near bed
- Adjustable closet rods, shelves, counter tops
- Emergency exit to outside
- Pocket or sliding interior doors
