 - Sharrow plans were passed out. It was said that the sharrow would be in the center lane.
 - Sharrow will be painted on the streets in the fall.
 - Group discussion about education on signage and what does a sharrow mean.
 - Information was passed out on the new “hawk” pedestrian signals that will be installed in the city.
 - Existing yellow flashing signals will be replaced with “hawk” signals. Locations are: (5) on 4th Plain, (2) on Mill Plain. Will replace (6) existing overhead pedestrian warning lights. New location Mill Plain and 157th Avenue.
