1. General welcome
2. Adoption of Meeting Notes – Jennifer made a motion to approve minutes from the October 23rd meeting “as is”, seconded by Chuck, unanimously approved.
3. Old Business
  - a. Sidewalk criteria
    - Michael Derleth
      - Current county criteria – mistake in how one of the criteria under health outcomes but will correct
      - Big picture, the criteria from the Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan was adopted
    - Brendon Haggerty
      - Walk time vs. distance
    - Steven Koch
      - Lists need to match
      - Need to work out how the criteria match
      - Bring back two separate lists for bicycles and pedestrians
    - Chuck Frayer
      - How can bikes and pedestrians be separate?
    - Steve Schulte – differences in distances for bikes vs. pedestrians
    - Chuck expressed concern with the amount of resources that staff devotes to the project ranking criteria and group should consider a comprehensive project of sidewalks in one neighborhood
    - Michael – would prefer of change the criteria of the currently used list
    - Steve – need to normalize the philosophies of the two lists
    - Chuck – growing elderly in the community
    - Michael – look at memo; look at sidewalk criteria; look for small tweaks

- Ultimately the changed list will be a docket item for the Bicycle & Pedestrian Plan
  - Steve, Laurie, Jennifer, Chuck, Brendon and Michael will hash out criteria

    - Challenge is tight timelines and budget
    - Find something that works for both sides
  - Steven Koch
    - Add language to mitigate for bike lanes and sidewalk removed
  - Ellen - When bike lanes go away, add better signage
  - Develop alternate language if bike lanes are removed
  - Develop alternate signing and striping
- c. MacArthur Boulevard Letter of Support
- Eric – is it realistic to remove slip lane?
  - The group thought it was acceptable to keep language regarding slip lane
  - Jennifer H. – question about removing on-street parking
  - Jennifer C. – parking issues on weekends at soccer fields at McLoughlin and MacArthur
  - Eric motioned to adopt the letter as is, Steven seconded, unanimously approved
