1. General welcome
 - a. Steve Valenta welcomed as a new member to the committee.
2. Adoption of Meeting Notes

3. Old Business
 - a. Memoranda of Understanding-Steve Schulte
 - Engineering memo: Steve expressed his issues regarding timelines.
 - Discussion ensued regarding how to quantify requests, create a ledger or some way to measure effectiveness of the memo.
 - Page 2, keep sidewalks if they already exist.
 - Add language regarding sidewalks.
 - Steve will take memo to Public Works and report back to BPAC about their reaction to the memo.
 - Sidewalk memo: combine item 2b and c to "meet and consult".
 - Ask Mark McCauley if BOCC needs to review.
 - Group supported sidewalk memo.
 - b. SR-503 & 99th Street-Steve Schulte
 - Intersection of 117th and 99th Streets scheduled to be improved in 2016.
 - Look at striping east on NE 99th Street east of 117th Street.
 - Question re. "Share the Road" sign on 99th Street, west of 117th Avenue.
 - Discussion ensued regarding use of "Share the Road" sign vs. "Bikes may use full Lane" sign.

- c. 99th Street and Highway 99-Steve Schulte
 - Overlay next summer and will add a northbound and southbound bike lane on Hwy 99.
 - Steve will research MUTCD regarding signing.
 - A question was asked if the county is considering slowing down streets as per the neighborhood streets law. The county is not considering lowering traffic speeds at this time.
 - An example of lowering street speed, 88th Street north of Luke Jensen park.
 - Laurie will follow up to see if an ordinance implementing the neighborhood streets ordinance is needed.
 - Steve will return to talk more about signage and bikes.

 - d. Goals and subcommittee assignments
 - Madeleine explained reasons behind the BPAC goals. Trish helped Madeleine with the revisions.
 - At each meeting, people to mention their volunteer efforts and what has been done.
 - Goal #6 to expand to volunteering in general.
 - Eric said he'll be the liaison to SSA. A motion was entered by Terry, seconded by Trish and Margaret.

 - President: Motion entered for Madeleine as President, Chuck as Vice-Chair. Seconded and passed unanimously.
