2. Adoption of Meeting Notes: Chris motioned to approve meeting notes from February as submitted, Terry seconded. All approved. 3. Staff Updates
 - Ken - WSDOT
 - Camas, WA: widening project
 - I-205: Looking at ramps at 18th Street, in design phase
 - Salmon Creek: bridge being built now
 - Camas/Washougal: Nickel & TPA, money enabled a packet of projects
 - Brendon-Public Health
 - Complete Streets
 - Draft code language developed
 - Draft assessment developed
 - Battle Ground and Camas are interested in moving forward with developing a complete streets code
 - Jennifer Campos-Vancouver:
 - Streets scheduled for sharrow this summer: McLoughlin, 97th, Columbia, St. Helens
 - "Monkey Shield Program"-Voluntary bike licensing program from Bad Monkey bikes so they can be traced if stolen
4. New Business
 - a. Renaissance Trail-Laurie gave an update.

- b. Bike to School Day-May 8th-Brendon
 - Need volunteers. Mostly involves fitting helmets during the day
 - Will send around a sign-up sheet for those interested in volunteering
 - c. Lower River Trail-Jennifer Campos
 - Laurie, Jennifer, Todd, Rob and Port of Vancouver staff met and discussed
 - Port is submitting a grant for transportation alternative funds.
 - Plan would be to put the path on the south side of Lower River Trail
 - Steve made a motion to send a letter of support for the grant application from the committee, seconded by Chris. All approved.
 - d. Critical Intersections-Madeleine
 - There was a discussion about problem intersections where loop detectors weren't working for bikes.
 - Remarks were made that jurisdictions should be contacted regarding the issues.
 - Recommendations were made for good staff contacts.
5. Old Business
- a. McArthur Blvd.-Madeleine
 - An update was provided.
 - The city will hold off on re-stripping.
 - The city will conduct a volume study.
 - The city Public Works department is re-examining this project.
 - A discussion took place about how to keep pressure on the city.
 - b. Engineering Memo-Laurie & Madeleine
 - Not much progress
6. Public Comments
- A question was raised about how to address vegetation along the bike lanes. Discussion ensued.
 - There was discussion regarding 15th Street under SR-500 as part of the project. Questions were asked about the signals installed there. The signals are temporary.
