1. Promote bicycle and pedestrian safety by supporting Bike Clark County's bicycle education programs and Community Health's Safe Routes to Schools by recruiting volunteers, volunteering ourselves and writing letters of support. Ongoing.

4. Promote the integration of bicycle and pedestrian facilities into Clark County's planning and project delivery process by advocating for the inclusion of such facilities on all public road improvements and private site plans. Specific areas of focus include:
 - ⑩ Implement formal review procedures that ensure modern bicycle and pedestrian facilities are considered on all public improvements,
 - ⑩ Build trust between Committee and Agencies by providing timely and objective review comments that consider all adopted planning codes, public works standards, and best practices.
 - ⑩ Advocate for specific stand-alone bicycle and pedestrian improvements that eliminate historical gaps in system connectivity or functionality, especially where planned improvements reduce the hurdles to eliminate such gaps. Ongoing.
