



Influenza-like Illness Report Form

Influenza-like illness (ILI) is defined as a fever of 100.0°F or greater and a cough or sore throat (in the absence of a known disease other than influenza) Annual influenza most commonly occurs in the winter; flu outbreaks can happen as early as October and can last as late as May.

Instructions: Please report to Clark County Communicable Disease Unit via fax or phone significant increases in school absenteeism resulting from influenza-like illness or clusters of particularly severe infections. (WAC 246-101-525)

When to report: Please report when absences of students/staff population are $\geq 10\%$ with similar symptoms of influenza like illness.

- If symptoms of illness are unknown for an absent student, include this student in your count of ILI absences.
