

\$2 RECYCLING CREDIT PROGRAM

Save \$2 by recycling more than 20 pounds or a 32-gallon container full of acceptable recyclable materials.

Bring more than 20 pounds or a 32-gallon container full of acceptable recyclable materials to county transfer stations (see back for locations) and save \$2 on that day's trash disposal costs.

ACCEPTABLE RECYCLABLE MATERIALS

Materials must be sorted and placed into designated bins to receive \$2 discount.

Empty aerosol cans—discard caps and recycle with tin cans

Tin cans—rinse and remove labels

Aluminum—rinse

Glass bottles & jars—rinse and remove labels

Plastic bottles & jugs—rinse and discard lids; flatten

Scrap metal—remove and discard any plastic or wood

Newspapers—leave loose; do not bundle or tie

Milk cartons & drink boxes—rinse; discard straws; flatten

Junk mail, magazines; paper bags; paperbacks and phonebooks; cereal and gift boxes; and other clean paper—leave loose; do not bundle or tie

Cardboard—flatten boxes

Including even one unacceptable material can contaminate the entire load. If in doubt, keep it out. For curbside recycling information, contact your service provider.

NO:

Full or partially full aerosol cans

Chemical or paint containers

Broken glass, window glass, light bulbs, mirrors,
or ceramics

Foil wrapping paper, plastic liners, waxed cardboard,
or juice concentrate containers

Food-contaminated cardboard or paper

Tissues, paper towels, or paper plates

Plastic bags, tubs (yogurt, margarine, etc.), Styrofoam®,
motor oil bottles, or toxic waste containers

Used tissues or paper towels
