ORDINANCE NO. M-4145

AN ORDINANCE fixing and levying the amount of ad valorem taxes necessary to balance estimated revenue with estimated expenditures for the 2015/2016 Budget for the City of Vancouver; providing for an effective date.

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the total net amount of \$45,500,000 in revenue must be raised by ad valorem taxes on real and personal property within the corporate limits of the City of Vancouver to balance estimated revenues and expenditures for the 2016 budget for the City of Vancouver.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF VANCOUVER:

Section 1. There is hereby fixed to be raised by general property taxes upon real and personal property within the City of Vancouver the amount of \$45,500,000, for the following purposes:

Section 2. The City Clerk is directed to transmit and file a certified copy of this ordinance with the Board of Clark County Commissioners and the Clark County Assessor following approval by City Council.

ORDINANCE NO. M-4146  
(RCW 84.55.120)

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annual property tax levy; authorizing an increase of 0.251% in the City's regular levy from the amount levied the previous year; and providing for an effective date.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Vancouver has met and considered its budget for the calendar years 2016; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Vancouver's actual levy amount from 2015 was \$44,267,755.49; and,

WHEREAS, the Implicit Price Deflator (IPD) rate released on September 28, 2015, is 0.251%, which is less than 1.0%. HB 2416 approved by the Washington State Legislature in 2007, limits the allowable increase to 1.0% or the IPD rate, whichever is lower; and

WHEREAS, the population of the City of Vancouver is more than 10,000.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF VANCOUVER:

Section 1. That an increase in the regular property tax levy is hereby authorized for the 2016 levy in the amount of \$111,112.07, which is a percentage increase of .0251% from the previous year. This increase is exclusive of additional revenue resulting from new construction,

improvements to property, any increase in the value of state-assessed property, any annexations that have occurred and refunds made.

Section 2. That the City Clerk is directed to transmit and file a certified copy of this ordinance with the Board of Clark County Commissioners and the Clark County Assessor following approval by City Council.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall go into effect five days after adoption.






