### **PUBLIC HEARING: MEDICAL MARIJUANA COLLECTIVE GARDENS**

Clark County currently has a moratorium in place on the siting of medical marijuana collective gardens. Such gardens are allowed under RCW Chapter 69.51A. The Board of County Commissioners (BOCC) asked the Clark County Planning Commission to consider two options for addressing medical marijuana collective gardens. The first option is a ban on such gardens anywhere in the county. The second is a proposal of where such gardens would be allowed and under what conditions. Included in the proposal could be such things as location criteria, signage, and hours of operation. Hearing continued from June 25, 2013. (Public testimony closed.)
