SUBJECT: Award of Bid #2616 – Concrete Railroad Crossing Panels

This bid shall result in a contract to supply concrete railroad crossing panels for the reconstruction of the railroad grade crossing on the Chelatchie Prairie Railroad located at East Main Street in Battle Ground, WA.

Purchasing received a sole response to Bid #2616. The bid was checked for accuracy, content, and compliance to specifications.

Invitations to bid were sent to eight vendors of whom one response was received. The Director of Economic Development reviewed the response and determined it to be in compliance to specification and within the departments' original estimate, which was developed through market research and previous bids. Purchasing feels there is sufficient information to insure competitive pricing.

Purchasing and the Director of Economic Development recommend that Bid #2616, be awarded to the sole bidder, Omega Industries, Inc. of Vancouver, WA in the total bid amount of \$30,219.75 including Washington State Sales Tax, and grant authority to the County Manager to sign all bid related contracts.
