For many years, Clark County Public Health, through a State Tobacco Youth Access grant program, regularly coordinated "sting" operations at local convenience stores, grocery stores, etc. aimed at educating establishments on sales of tobacco products to minors. The grant funds that funded this activity are no longer available. Clark County Public Health is requesting this account be closed.
