## BACKGROUND

Current Clark County Code Title 9 Public Peace, Safety and Morals contains section 24.010 which outlines the type, quantity and outside locations an individual may store items. Along with waste, building materials and other accumulated items, it also specifically addresses inoperable vehicles. The code however does not address inoperable boats in either the rural or urban areas. This proposed code amendment includes inoperable boat regulation.

A distinction is outlined for rural areas allowing up to two (2) inoperable boats and/or automobiles while the urban area allows none.
